#### **About The Music Man**

Professor Harold Hill is a con man. He travels from town to town selling kids' band instruments and uniforms. He then skips out with the money before teaching the kids how to play. Professor Hill, in fact, does not know how to read music! However, River City, Iowa is a town that needs what Professor Hill has to offer. Watch as the town changes under Harold Hill's guidance.

The original production of THE MUSIC MAN ran for 1,375 performances on Broadway. It was really a sensation.

Before achieving success as a Broadway writer, Meredith Willson was a popular radio personality and bandleader who occasionally worked with Frank Loesser (who wrote Guys and Dolls). Loesser so believed in this show that he backed it for years of development and produced the original production. It made a star of Robert Preston and Marian was played by Barbara Cook, who went on to be one of the most celebrated Broadway singers in history. The Music Man is unquestionably one of the most beloved shows of all time.
